

Ozaukee Bank Forges Alliance with Cedarburg Soccer

In recognition of a newly forged partnership with Ozaukee Bank, the Cedarburg Soccer Club announced that it has renamed its 13.9 acre soccer field complex, located behind St. Mary's Pioneer Road Clinic, "Ozaukee Bank Soccer Fields". Mark Schwantes, President of the Cedarburg Soccer Club, reported that Ozaukee Bank has agreed to a significant contribution to the Club and to continue its long-standing sponsorship of recreational program uniforms.

This equates to membership of over 675 families who participate in competitive play.
